#### **GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION**

Kabikankan Mukundaram Mahavidyalaya is situated at Keshabpur, Hooghly near the birthplace (Daminya) of Kabikankan Mukundaram Chakraborty. It is located on the western bank of river Mundeswari and has a unique geographical location. The education enthusiasts of the locality had felt the dire need of a college, established one, in the year 2007. The local people were greatly benefited as their kiths and kins would now be ensured of quality education in their own locality. Many poor meritorious students, a majority of them being first generation learners, would get better scope of education and subsequently acquire good placements. Thus the college which is 16 kms away from Arambagh, 23 kms from Tarakeshawar via Kable More and 47 kms away from Burdwan, is expected to become one of the leading academic institutions of the district.
